## OPTION 1: SINGLE PEG BOARD

This is where your Peg Board adventure begins. Pay attention to the Pics, do it right and you'll set yourself for future Peg Boarding glory.

## STEP 3

Insert Safety Pins into all 4x Brackets and you'll stop your Peg Board doing anything crazy, like tipping over.


Give yourself (and your friend) a hi-five! You've got this pegged.

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When a single Peg Board is not enough; let's learn how to stack 'em.

SPD Place your Peg Board 2.0 above your existing one, and slot it straight into the next available Slots on the Uprights. Once it's sitting pretty, slot the Angled Bracket between the $2 x$ Peg Boards, align the Bolt Holes and secure with the supplied Nuts and Bolts.

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## OPTION 3: SIDE-BY SIDE PEG BOARDS

When a single Peg Board is not enough and if you can't stack them vertically, you can always go horizontal. .

STEP 2
Insert a Bolt through all 6x Holes of each Angled Bracket and the


Attach 2x Brackets to each side of your now super-wide double Peg Board. The Top Brackets slot into the 1st and 3rd Hole positions. And the Bottom Brackets slot into the 7th and 9th Hole positions.

## STEP 4

With one person at each end, while holding the Brackets lift the super-wide double Peg Board into position.


Hot tip:
For best results attach the Bottom Brackets into the 2nd and 3rd Upright Slots above a Workbench Shelf. Then you can marvel at those perfectly stashed precious things whenever you like.

## OPTION 4: $2 \times 2$ PEG BOARDS

You're now a Peg Board Master. And you want to take your storage capability to the next level.


Assemble the Top half of the Peg Board, this time aligning the Angled Bracket with the Holes on the Top edge. Then fix the Angled Bracket off with $6 x$ Nuts and Bolts.

Attach $2 \times$ Brackets to each side of your Top half super-wide double Peg Board. Slot the Top Brackets into the 2nd and 4th Hole positions, and the Bottom Brackets into the 8th and 10th Hole positions.


Top brackets to be inserted into the 2nd and 4th hole positions.

Bottom brackets to be inserted into the 8th and 10th hole positions.

## STEP 4

With one person at each end, while holding the Brackets lift the super-wide double Peg Board into position above your Bottom half. Once your Top half is in place, insert an Angled Bracket between the $2 x$ Peg Board halves and secure with the supplied Nuts and Bolts.


You've done it! Cue warm inner feeling of satisfaction.
Stand back and marvel at your Rack It Peg Board(s). Give yourself (and your friend) a hi-five for the last time! You've got this well pegged. Now is the time to enjoy tossing these instructions in the recycling.
